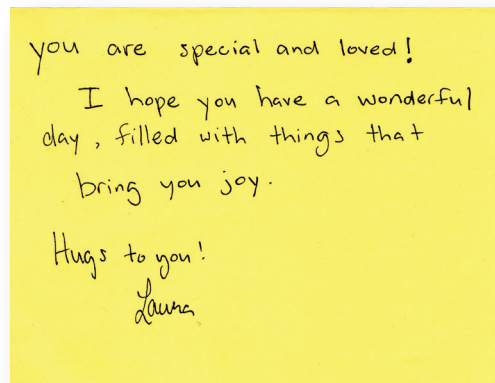
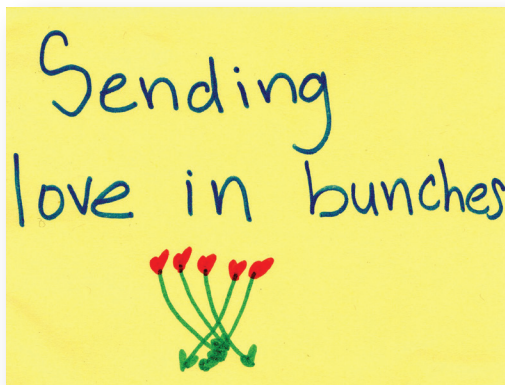


Thank you for joining **United4Neighbors: Notes of Encouragement!** Your next steps are to create your notes and send or deliver them to us. Below, you'll find further instructions.

Guidelines for Creating your Notes of Encouragement:

- **Make your note** as simple or as creative as you like! We encourage you to use what you have on hand, around your house, or feel free to purchase materials of your choice.
- **Writing must be legible** (large print) if handwritten.
- **Avoid religion and politics.** Your note should resonate with anyone.
- **Exclude the date** (day, month, and year).
- **Recipients love it when notes are personal.** Feel free to include details, like what your summer plans are, or a new hobby you've learned. But remember, this is a one-way note exchange, meaning you will not receive a note back. Reciprocation (like asking questions that require a response) shouldn't be included.
- **Placing your note in an envelope is preferred**, but not required. Leave your enveloped notes unsealed and unstamped and put them in a larger envelope for mail or delivery.
- **Consider creating a few extra notes** to share with family, friends and neighbors.
- **Please practice safe hygiene.** Wash your hands before writing notes and do not seal envelope when finished.



Where do I send my completed notes?

1. Write your notes! We will continue to collect pledges and notes until we reach our goal of 15,000 notes.
