- E-filing (Site Coordinator)




Link & Learn: certify with the IRS

- Link & Learn is the IRS platform for certifying VITA volunteers.
- Access <u>Link & Learn</u> to set up your account.

Note: Those seeking CE credits should review IRS guidance in <u>Pub 5362</u> and make sure to enter their "professional status for CE credits" when registering in Link & Learn. **Advanced** certification is the bare minimum qualification for CE credits.

Certification Tests



Step 1: All volunteers take the Volunteer Standards of Conduct Test.

Step 2: All volunteers take the Intake/Interview and Quality Review Test.

Step 3: All preparers/reviewers take at least the basic test, but preferably the advanced!

Note: 80% is considered a passing grade and everyone can re-test once per test.



- Sign into your <u>Link & Learn</u> account.
- Go to 2023 VITA/TCE Certification Test tab.
- Go to Advanced tab.
- Select Volunteer Standards of Conduct Exam.
- Take the exam.

Take the Intake/Interview & Quality Review Test

- Sign into your <u>Link & Learn</u> account.
- Go to Certification Test tab.
- Go to Advanced tab.
- Select 2023 Intake/Interview and Quality Review Exam.
- Take the exam.

- You took and passed the VSOC and Intake/Interview tests!
 Now you are ready to participate in tax preparer training
 Parts A and B. Sign up here if you have not already done so.
- Even if you are convinced you only want to help in the greeting and intake process, preparer training makes you much better at both!
- To prepare returns, you will need to take either the Basic or Advanced certification exam.



Practice Tax Returns

- Both exams will require you to create practice tax returns.
- We use an IRS provided software called TaxSlayer Pro - it adequately handles all types of VITA returns.
- TaxSlayer provides a special "practice area" for you to create your practice returns.
- Let's get started:

TaxSlayer Software

- TaxSlayer Pro for VITA
- Select <u>Practice Lab.</u>
- Enter universal password: TRAINPROWEB (all CAPS)
- Create your personal account:
 - Remember to record username and password on your password sheet!
 - The Password has a 15-digit requirement.
- Select Go to Practice Area.
- Select Start New 2023 Tax Return.
- Select Start Return.




Create TaxSlayer Account

Volunteer Liability Protection

Volunteer Protection:

The Volunteer Protection Act generally protects unpaid volunteers from liability for acts or omissions that occur while acting within the scope of their responsibilities at the time of the act or omission.

It provides no protection from harm caused by willful or criminal misconduct, gross negligence, reckless misconduct, or a conscious, blatant disregard of the rights or safety of the individual harmed by the volunteer.
